HumeLink East project update

Humelink is one of Australia's largest energy infrastructure projects, connecting renewable energy sources to the grid and helping to put downward pressure on energy prices.

The project consists of 365 kilometres of 500 kV overhead transmission lines connecting Wagga Wagga, Bannaby and Maragle and new or upgraded infrastructure at four substations. Construction will occur in two sections, known as Humelink East and Humelink West, Humelink East Joint Venture (ACCIONA and

Genus) is

delivering the eastern section of the Humelink project for Transgrid. This will include construction of around 250 kilometres of 500kV overhead transmission lines and expansion of the Bannaby 500kV substation to connect with the Humelink West section at Wondalga.


